by an Act made in the Thirty-second Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, were amended and continued until the Twenty-sifth Day of December One thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight; and which were, by another Act made in the Thirty-eighth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, further continued until the Twenty-sifth Day of December One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued until the Twenty-sifth Day of December One thousand eight hundred.

II. And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the Seventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act to discontinue, for a limited Time, the Duties payable upon the Importation of Tallow, Hogs Lard, and Grease, which was to be in force for Three Years, from the Twenty-sifth Day of March One thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; and which by several subsequent Acts of the Tenth, Thirteenth, Sixteenth, Nineteenth, Twenty-second, Twenty-sixth, Twenty-ninth, Thirty-second, and Thirty-sifth Years of the Reign of His said Majesty, was surther continued from the Expiration thereof until the Twenty-sifth Day of March One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued until the Twenty-sisth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and six.
