II. And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the Seventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to discontinue, for a limited Time, the Duties payable upon the Importation of Tallow, Hogs Lard, and Grease*, which was to be in force for Three Years, from the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; and which by several subsequent Acts of the Tenth, Thirteenth, Sixteenth, Nineteenth, Twenty-second, Twenty-sixth, Twenty-ninth, Thirty-second, and Thirty-fifth Years of the Reign of His said Majesty, was further continued from the Expiration thereof until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and six.
