CAP. XIX.

An Act for importing Salt from. Europe into the Province of Quebec in America, for a limited Time.



hereas the Rivers, Bays, and Picamble Coass, of the Colony of Quebec in America, and the Seas adjoining, are commodiously siz tuated for carrying on a very advantageous Fishery, to the great Benefit of the Inhabitants of the faid Colony, and to the extending the Commerce, and increasing the Riches of these Kingdoms: And whereas it would be of great Advan-

tage to the faid fishery, if his Majedy's Subjects were permitted to import Salt into the said Colony directly from Fozeign Parts, in like Manner as is allowed with respect to the fisheries of New England, Nova Scotia, and Newfoundland, by several Laws now in being: Way it please your most Excellent Wajesty, that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Hajesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lozds Spiritual and Tempozal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That from and after the Twenty From and afficurth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and 1764, Saltmay fixty four, it thall and may be lawful to and for any of be imported in British Vele his Majedy's Subjects to carry and import Salt from lels,
