Bennett Lecture And Seminar To Examine Aboriginal Issues

Former Micmac chief Albert Levi will give the 17th annual Viscount Bennett Memorial Lecture at the University of New Brunswick in Fredericton on Thursday, Nov. 4.

His talk, entitled Reflections on Changes in the Political Position of New Brunswick's Aboriginal Peoples During the past 25 years, will be given at 4:30 PM in Ludlow Hall, room 2. Both the lecture and the reception that follows are open to the public and free of charge.

The public is also invited to attend the Bennett Seminar, which will deal with topics related to the lecture and will be held in the same location on Friday, Nov. 5, starting at 9 AM. The seminar will consist of three sessions, each with three speakers and a session chairperson. Invited participants with expertise in appropriate fields, including aboriginal identity and culture, sovereignty and treaties, and aboriginal economic development, will lead the sessions and open the floor to discussion at the end.

The McEuen Undergraduate Scholarship For Study In Scotland 1994-95 University of St. Andrews

The McEuen Scholarship is awarded annually in memory of Dr. Charles Stuart McEuen to a Canadian student resident in Canada.

Value: The scholarship is tenable for a three-year course of studies toward the ordinary degree or a four-year course toward an honors degree. It is renewable from year to year on the basis of satisfactory performance, and cover all tuition fees and residence costs and a stipend for basic expenses.

Conditions: Applicants must not be more than 21 years of age and must be attending university in Canada or be qualified for admission into a university in Canada. The winner is chosen on the

basis of outstanding academic achievement and leadership potential.

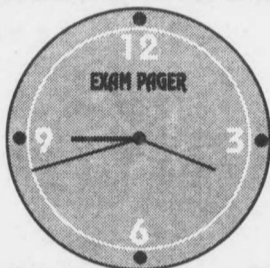

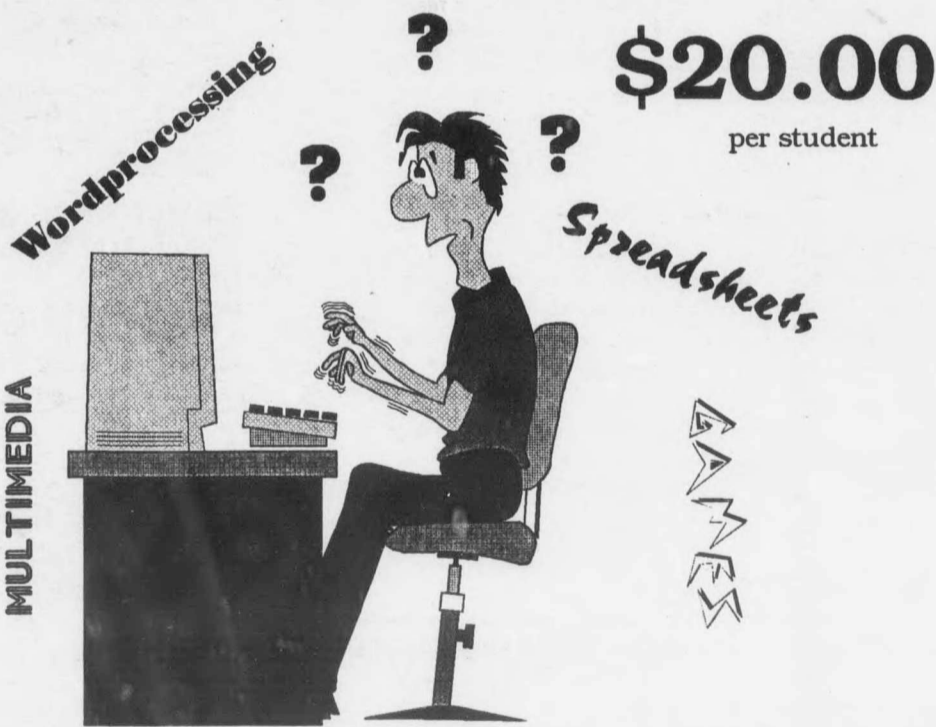
