Amount: Two \$3,000 scholarships
Tenure: Open to all students undertaking full-time undergraduate studies at a Canadian university or college.
Eligibility: Canadian citizen or landed immigrants of any age who, through their work or their involvement in the community, have demonstrated maturity and a commitment to the social ideas, which characterized the life of A.A. Heaps. Applicants should have a knowledge regarding the contribution which A.A. Heaps

made in the field of social reform.
Deadline: Postmarked by May 15, 1995
Procedure: No special application is required. Applicant must submit a typed essay of between 500 and 1,000 words outlining his or her education, employment history, background in community work, and a commitment to social ideas. Applicant's essay should show a knowledge regarding the contribution which A.A. Heaps made in the field of social reform. the applicant's name, age, address and telephone number should appear at the top of the application. At the end of the application, the applicant must include the name, address and telephone number of two references who are prominent in the community and knowledgeable about the applicant's background and dedication to the philosophy underlying the Scholarship. Applicant's financial circumstances should also be indicated. Please send your essay and related material along with your most recent academic transcript to: A.A.
