The plan of the reserves for the Little Shuswap Lake Indians is forwarded by this mail as requested in your letter above referred to.

I shall be much obliged if you will cause me to be furnished with a complete set of the plans of surveys within the Railway belt, published by the Department of the Interior, shewing the Indian lands thereon, for at present I have no means of knowing whether all the reserves are shewn on them or not.
