Sir:-

I have to call your attention to the amount of the third instalment of purchase money which becomes due on your land in St. Peters Reserve on the 16th instant as follows,

Principal --- \$78.50

Interest --- 12.08

Total ---- \$90.68

As the money is required by the Department for the use of the Indian you will be good enough to forward same on receipt of this communication.

In the matter of the first instalment it is found that on the south L.S D.5, Sec. 32, Tp. 14, Rge. 6 E there is a shortage of \$4.81. The total purchase of this land amounted to \$172.50 and one quarter of this sum amounts to \$43.12, being the first payment, but the first payment recorded as made by you is \$38.31 and I have to ask that you will be good enough to forward the difference of \$4.81 with the third instalment .
