- 23. (a) Bren Guns 250 Bren Guns were delivered by the manufacturer to Ordnance, Toronto. 86 of these will be sent overseas and the balance distributed to Coast Defence and 4th Division Units in Canada.
  - (b) 25-pdr. Guns Two 25-pdr. guns were received and are being distributed to Petawawa and Winnipeg.
  - (c) Signal and Wireless Equipment The following signal and wireless equipment was received from suppliers:

## GENERAL STORES

- 24. (a) Clothing and Necessaries The provision position is satisfactory and stocks adequate. Action was taken to supply additional requirements requested from overseas. New specifications for Caps, Winter, Melton Cloth were approved. The new caps, which have a lighter lining, will be ready for issue by the end of November.
  - (b) Web Equipment, Pattern 1937 The stocks are adequate and the provision position is satisfactory. Authority was given to issue on repayment, 2000 sets to the Royal Canadian Navy. 500 of these sets are for immediate delivery and the balance will be delivered in monthly shipments.
  - (c) Helmets, Steel Delivery continues at the satisfactory rate of 200 steel helmets daily.
  - (d) Anti-Gas Glothing 9523 assorted garments were received and 14,016 were issued. 3200 Detectors, Gas, Tippet Pattern, were received.
  - (e) Respirators Anti-Gas Receipts were 1420 and issues 1870.
