Lieut. Elding was the popular Adjutant of the 219th Battalion. Transferred to the 46th Battalion, and killed near Amiens, August 10th, 1918. Leaves a widow and three children.



CAPT. W. H. WALKER

This officer transferred to Flying Corps, proceeding to France with 11th Squadron Bristol Fighters. He did great work, but was killed in his machine. Leaves a widow.

LIEUT. G. C. QUAIL

Transferred to 1st C.M.R.'s and killed 1st January, 1918, at Hill 70. Leaves a widow and one child.
