From the Cæsus Mine, in Munro Township, twelve miles from Matheson, on the Timiskaming and Northern Ontario Railway, five pieces of ore have been purchased by the Ontario Bureau of Mines. They together weigh 38,689 grams, and contain 16,431 grams of gold and silver. This is equivalent to 528.28 oz. gold and silver, of which 480.7 oz. is gold and 47.5 is silver, the total value being about \$9,966.

Returns collected by the Ontario Bureau of Mines for the three months ending March 31 show that there was produced 127,692 oz. of gold, value \$2,601,760, against \$107,818 oz. in 1916; 3,945,957 oz. of silver, value \$2,831,873, against 5,297,831 oz.; 10,141 tons of nickel (in matte), value \$5,070,410, against 10,032 tons; 5,063 tons of copper (in matte), value \$2,025,227, against 5,491 tons; and 163,020 tons of pig-iron, value \$2,743,441, against 160,749 tons.
