

communicate and officially deliver, or allow copies to be taken or, if thereunto required, Extracts only, of all the said Titles, reports of the Commission, and papers, to or by, such Committees as may be authorized by the House to that effect.

Mr. *Bedard* moved, seconded by Mr. *Menut* that the question of concurrence be now put on the resolve of the Committee.

The House divided on the question.

Majority of eight in the Affirmative.

The said resolution of the Committee being again read throughout by the Clerk and the question of concurrence put thereupon, the House again divided.
