—TO THE QUEEN.

1. *Joint*.—Praying the removal of the restrictions of the Treaty of 1818, prohibiting American citizens from fishing within certain prescribed limits, on the shores of this Island, on certain conditions. Committee to prepare, and Council desired to join, 23. Reported from Joint Committee, and adopted, 34.

2. Praying that instructions may be transmitted to the Lieutenant Governor, that it is Her Majesty's pleasure the Bill to compel the registration of the Original Grants or Patents of Lots or Townships of Land in this Island, be passed into a Law.
