EDUCATION AND THE REFORMATION.

The latest number of the Messenger
of the Sacred Heart contains a
very instructive article, from the
pen of the well known Jesuit, Rev.
James Conway, on "The Decline of
Education in Germany in Consequence
of the Reformation." Fr. Conway
well says at the outset of his
paper that, despite all the proofs
to the contrary that have been ad-
duced, the Protestant Reformation
still continues to figure in popular
text books, and to be spoken of by
Protestant historians, as a time
when popular education first began
for the world; and that statement
once made, the conclusion is drawn
from it that all the benefits which
came from popular enlightenment are
to be ascribed to the same cause;
to wit, the Reformation, which is
pictured as a sort of universal Re-
naissance. In order to get over the
undeniable facts of history, which
show that many of the things which
are ascribed to the Reformation
really had place years before
its happening, these same writers,
the learned Jesuit confessors, have not
hesitated to declare that the Re-
formation itself occurred at an
earlier period than it actually did,
and in some cases they so tamely
happening by a full half century.
Yet it should be borne in mind, he
adds, by the student of history, that
the Reformation really began in
Luther's time, and that it had no
existence prior to the day when that
rebellious monk nailed his heretical
teachings on the door of the church
at Wittenburg, October 3, 1517.
That date marks the line of demar-
cation between two epochs, and Pro-
testantism can claim credit for
nothing that was done in behalf of
education, culture, progress, etc.,
before that time. For all previous
achievements in those directions,
Fr. Conway justly claims, belong to
the Church under whose influence
they were wrought; and he pointed-
ly remarks, furthermore, that "what-
ever the Reformers themselves
could boast of in the way of culture
was due to the fostering care of the
Church, and not to the influence of
the Protestant Reformation."
