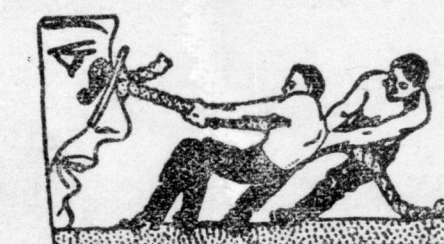

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SIX SMALL CHILDREN**WILL BE CARED FOR**

Taken From Thorndale to the Shelter in South London.

Victoria: No soap of no kind or in any form should be used as a shampoo. All soap contains "free" alkali, which is too strong for the hair.
