# TO BE SHOCKED TO DEATH.

ELEVENTH YEAR.

MURDERER KEMMLER AWAITING HIS DOOM AT AUBURN PRISON.

Will Do the Fatal Work Some Day During its Week Beginning April 28— Kommier a Changed Man—The Store

Kemmler, the Buffalo murderer, has made its tour of the courts of this state, resulting in the confirmation of the original sentence, There is no hope for him and he will be put to death in Anbura Prison by the application of electricity some day in the week beginning April 28. The day will be selected by the warden, Charles F. Durston. Kemmler is a rough, ignorant fellow and brought all his rouble upon himself by the excessive use of whisky. During his trial several witnesses restified that he frequently absorbed as much as a quart of whisky in half an hour, and often made wagers with his companions that he could hold more liquor than they—wagers he invariably won.

And Kemmler, what of him? What are his feelings as he sits in his dungeon in a secluded part of Auburn Prison? He is not classed as a convict. He does not wear the prison food. His food is furnished from the warden's kitchen. When received at the prison he could neither read nor write. Now, in consequence of the labors of Mrs, Durston and Donald McNaughton, the death-watch, he can sign his name with a pen in plain, bold letters. He can read also, but very slowly. One day after listening to McNaughton read eight chapters of the Book of Job, Kemmler remarked that if he had heard that read a year before he would never have harmed Tillie Zeigler.

He maintained a brutal stolidity when arrested, and his only remark was: "Yes, I have done it, and I am willing to take the rope for it." Kemmler was sentenced May 14, was removed to Auburn Prison May 23, and has only been outside its walls once—when he was taken to Buffalo to be resentenced.
