

THE LIVERPOOL TIMBER STOCK.

The following table shows the quantity of the various classes of timber in stock at Liverpool, England, on October 31st, for two years :

\$22.10 for white pine, \$22.10 and \$10.10 for spruce ; and the " Britannia," from Bear River, with 300 M. shipping white pine boards, 25 M. plank, and 25 M. shipping spruce, which was placed at \$24 shipping white pine boards, \$22.50 plank, and \$21 spruce ; and second quality white pine at \$20. Other cargoes of white pine and spruce have been contracted for on C. & F. terms, so that the dealers are now sure of supplies. A cargo of 40 M. white pine and 50 M. spruce was offered yesterday from a neighboring port, but nothing has yet been done with it. Shingles—Nothing further to report under this head. We are expecting a cargo of cedar laying. Shooks and Staves—The Str. Madiana brought 3,500 bds. former from various consignees ; and we have had the A. C. Wade, from Portland, with 10,400 to selves, and 1,800 bds. to neighbours ; cargo contracted for some time ago. We are expecting a cargo of staves at the end of this month.

THE BARBADOS MARKET.
