Easy Stages

Canada celebrated its centennial in 1967 in part by building theatres all over. There are now perfectly splendid auditoriums from coast to coast. Some of the best in summer operation are:

Neptune Theatre, Halifax, Nova Scotia, seats 525. A professional repertory theatre, it has been operating for fourteen summers.

Confederation Centre Theatre, Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, seats 1,076. It has no permanent company but is host to local and touring groups.

Royal Alexandra Theatre, Toronto, seats 1,500. Touring companies, ballet, drama and choral groups all perform.

National Arts Centre, Ottawa, seats 2,300 in the opera house, 800 in the theatre. Standing on six and a half acres in Confederation Square near the Parliament buildings, it includes an opera house,
