- (a) after full consideration of the case, the competent authorities in either country refuse to grant the benefits applied for;
- (b) the competent authorities prohibit the exhibition of the co-production in either country or its export to a third country;
- (c) either party fails to fulfil its commitments;
- 10. The shooting schedule;
- 11. A clause stipulating that the majority co-producer shall take an insurance policy covering at least "all production risks" and "all original material production risks".
- C. A list of the creative and technical personnel indicating their nationalities and, in the case of performers, the roles they are to play.

The competent authorities of the two countries can demand any further documents and all other additional information deemed necessary.

III. Amendments including the replacement of a co-producer may be made in the original contract but they must be submitted for approval by the competent authorities of both countries before the co-production is finished. The replacement of a co-producer may be allowed only in exceptional cases after approval of both competent authorities. The competent authorities of both countries shall communicate their decisions to each other at the earliest possible date.
