Surely, this kind of bill which can introduce into the residential mortgage business, I would estimate, some \$500 million almost immediately should not be turned down. Surely, we should pass this legislation to attract that money into the residential mortgage business and make that contribution toward solving the problems we have. I hope hon. members will support the bill.
