Dear Dr. Fryer:-

I am returning herewith the correspondence re the Wolfe pistols.

I have written to Mr. Lighthall to say that at the last meeting of the Finance Committee it was agreed to make available for the McCord Museum the \$1,500. necessary to purchase these pistols. The Governors expect that the Museum authorities will take every possible precaution to verify the gentineness of these pistols. It is also to be understood that the \$1,500. is in the nature of an advance to the members to be repaid when any considerable amount of funds become available for museum purposes.

I am also returning the correspondence re the Indian collection, and would say that if the Committee is satisfied that this collection should be bought the necessary funds will be made available under the same conditions outlined re the purchase of Wolfe pistols.
