

CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE I.—MEETINGS.

SECTION 1.—The Annual Meeting of the Early Annual Closing and Young Men's Mutual Improvement Meeting, Association of Halifax, shall be held on the fifth Time and place of. day of February of each year, at such time and place as the Committee of Management may appoint; and five days notice thereof shall be given by the Secretary, by publication in one or more newspapers in Halifax City, or by notice given Notice of. to each member personally, or deposited in the Post Office, directed to his address, as appearing on the books of the Association. Such meetings Adjournment of. may be adjourned from time to time without further notice; and in case there should in any year be a failure to give seasonable notice of the Annual Meeting the same may be held on the same Failure to give notice of. day of the following week, after notice given as above prescribed.

SECTION 2.—The Regular Meeting of this Association shall be held on the first Monday of each Regular Meeting. month; but for sufficient cause the President may direct the same to be held at any time during the first ten days of each month.

SEC. 3.—Special Meetings of the Association Special Meetings. may be called by the President, and shall be so Requisition for. called upon a requisition signed by at least ten per cent. of its members, stating the object of such meeting.

Public notice shall be given of all Special Notice of. Meetings, and at such meetings no business shall Business at. be transacted except that specified in the requisition.
