

PROMOTION OF THE OBJECTS OF THE CLUB.

11. The means for furthering the purpose of the Club shall be the reading of essays and delivery of addresses on subjects within the scope of the Club, and the non-partisan discussion of matters affecting the welfare and progress of the Dominion; but no topic shall be discussed by the Club or any member thereof at any meeting of the Club which shall tend to endanger the welfare or harmony of the Club; and a member called to order by the presiding officer shall immediately submit to the ruling of the Chair. No vote shall be taken on any question at issue between political parties.

MANAGEMENT.

12. (a) Subject to special action by the Club the conduct of its affairs, its discipline and management shall be vested in the Trustees.

(b) The Trustees shall arrange the order in which papers or other subjects for consideration shall be brought before the meetings of the Club.

(c) The Trustees shall meet at the call of the President on notice in writing mailed or delivered at least two days before the date of the meeting, and four members shall constitute a quorum.

(d) Should the President be unable to call a meeting, or should he refuse or fail to call a meeting of the Trustees on the request of any one of the Trustees, it shall be in order at any time after any inability arises, or one week after such request for three of the Trustees to call such a meeting on notice as aforesaid.
