afford the means of reference, it becomes necessary that every person so
applying should make a separate and distinct application in the form of
a Petition to the Lieutenant Governor which Petition should set forth
the exertions the party has made, and the difficulties under which he
labors; and, further, that each such Petition should be accompanied by a
Certificate from some respectable person, affirming upon his personal
knowledge that the facts therein alleged are correct.
