along the headline between the Tenth and Eleventh Concessions of the said Township, forty feet; thence North parallel to the side line until it strikes the South line of a Lot known as the Mill Lot; thence West forty feet, or until it strikes the North-east corner post of a Village Lot owned by Sylvester Cheney; thence South parallel to the side line to the place of beginning. Also a street running in a Westerly direction from the above mentioned street, as follows: Commencing at the South-east corner post of the above mentioned Village Lot owned by Sylvester Cheney; thence running West parallel

to the headline, two hundred and sixty-six feet; thence South parallel to the sideline, forty feet; thence East parallel to the headline, two hundred and sixty-six feet, or until it strikes the street leading to the Mill Lot; thence North along the West side of said street leading to the Mill Lot, to the place of beginning, of the width of not less than forty feet.
