

benefits, every member present, the President and Vice-President chosen for the same year, only excepted, shall draw lots, and he that draws No. 1 shall execute that office for one year, or pay a fine of fifteen shillings, and form ourselves the drawing to be renewed until one is found to serve: known by the and whoever serves or pays the fine for not serving, E-COMPANY shall not draw again, until every member in the company has done the same. The Clerk is to receive all fines and forfeitures, to settle all reckonings at meetings, and to account with the company for all monies he may receive, and disburse, during the time he is in office, and as often as the company may think proper to call upon him; he is also to warn all meetings by leaving a summons at each member's house two days before the time of meeting; likewise to call on four of the members, once in every quarter, in rotation, as they stand on the list, to accompany him for the purpose of examining into the state of the buckets, bags and baskets, and of observing that the regulations of this company are punctually adhered to, and likewise to be better acquainted with the dwellings of each other. The Clerk is also to keep a fair and perfect minute of all the transactions of the company, and to report to the President, at every quarterly meeting, all deficiencies, that he may discover, either in buckets, bags or baskets at the time of his visiting the members as aforesaid. Any member refusing to make his visit in his turn, shall be reported by the Clerk and pay a fine of one dollar.
