

CROWN CHARTERED TAKE VER DAVIDSON CLAIMS

Aggressive Development Proves Up the Property and Option is Exercised.

One of the most important deals yet made in Porcupine was that consummated yesterday in Montreal, when the directors of the Crown Chartered company exerolead the option given them a few weeks since on the Davidson property and formally took over the claims from the syndicate of Toronto mining men, by whom they were recently purchased for the company.

The shaft will be pushed to the 125-ft. level with all possible expedition, and it is expected this point will be reached by Oct. 15.
