TO DRIVE BACK TROOPS MENACING PETROGRAD

Copenhagen, Aug. 10.—A despatch from Petrograd, dated Friday, reports that the Bolshevik government has decided to accept the proposal of Zinoviev, the Bolshevik governor of Petrograd, to drive back the troops of General Judenich, commander-in-chief of the forces operating against Petrograd from the south, to the Estonian frontier.

The Bolshevik ministers have also decided to carry on in Estonia Bolshevik propaganda, which they consider their most effective weapon.
