FOREIGNERS SOLD WHEAT.

The Trade Was Light at Chicago and Liverpool Cables a Penny Lower.

A Small Increase in the Visible Supply—Exports Were Small—Improved Outlook in France—Provisions Weaker at Chicago.

Monday Evening, Jan. 10. Liverpool wheat futures are 3/4 to 1/4 lower. Cash wheat in Chicago 1/4c lower at 91c. May wheat on curb 90 3/4c.

Receipts of grain at Chicago today: Wheat, 450,000 bushels, against 410,000 bushels for Tuesday; Wheat 75, corn 80, oats 105.

Exports at New York today: 30,000 bushels of wheat, 10,000 bushels of corn, 10,000 bushels of oats.

Receipts of wheat at Minneapolis and Duluth today were 534 cars.

Human shipments of wheat for the week were 1,200,000 bushels, against 1,340,000 bushels the corresponding week of last year. Danish shipments of wheat for the week were 32,000 bushels.
