Major Stanberry to Command Special to Toronto World

St. Thomas, April 6.—Major Stanberry, who went overseas as second in command of the 25th Battalion, and who lately returned, has been appointed lieutenant-colonel of the 25th Regiment here, which will be raised to full strength for home defence. Since his return to Canada Major Stanberry has been in charge of mobilization at Windsor, but arrived in St. Thomas today to take up his new duties.

FOE MAKES ATTACK ON DWINA FRONT

A Russian Counter-Attack Ejects Germans South of Riga. BIG AIRCRAFT RAIDS. French Machines Throw Shells on Foe Battery in Dobrudja.

Petrograd, via London, April 6.—German forces yesterday took the offensive in the region south of Riga and succeeded in penetrating the Russian lines, says an official statement issued today by the Russian war department. Later the Russians launched a counter-attack, drove out the Germans and restored the position.

RUSSIAN FRONT: IN THE DIRECTION OF THE BYSTRITSA RIVER

The text of the statement reads: "Western front: After heavy artillery preparation, mainly with shells charged with chemicals, the Germans took the offensive and occupied part of our trenches to the east of Pskov, 13 miles south of Riga. The enemy was driven out as the result of our counter-attack and the position was restored."

U. S. COURTS WILL TEST WAR NATURALIZATION

Federal Judge Grants Application of German for Test Case. New York, April 6.—Whether a German can become a naturalized American citizen during war time will be settled by the test case of Jonas Meyer, who was granted his final papers here today by Federal Judge Mayer with the understanding that the action would be contested by the government.

GERMAN AIRMEN BOMB KENTISH COAST TOWNS

Hostile Machine Breaks Some Glass in Midnight Visit. London, April 6.—Towns on the coast of Kent were again bombarded last night by German aeroplanes. The aeroplanes were seen in the air over the coast at 11.30 p.m. and were seen to drop bombs on the coast.

BRYAN OFFERS TO GO TO WAR AS PRIVATE

Ex-Secretary of State for U. S. Volunteers to President. Tallahassee, Florida, April 6.—Former Secretary Bryan today sent this message to President Wilson: "Believing it to be the duty of each citizen to bear his part of the burden of war and his share of its perils, I hereby tender my services to the government. Please enroll me as a private whenever I am needed. Assign me to any work that I can do until called to the colors. I am a member of the National Reserve Corps and I am ready to go to the front with the rank of colonel, commanded a regiment of Nebraska volunteers during the Spanish-American war."
