

## REPORT OF INSTITUTIONS.

The Colleges and Schools connected with the Methodist Church in Canada may be classified as follows:—

### I. Connexional Institutions.

These are such as are vested in the entire Church, and are under the direct control of the General Conference. They are Victoria University, Cobourg; Mount Allison University, Sackville, N.B.; Wesleyan Theological College, Montreal; Albert College, Belleville; Alma Ladies' College, St. Thomas; and Wesley College, Winnipeg. Reports for the past year have been received from these several institutions, as follows:—

VICTORIA UNIVERSITY, Cobourg, was founded as the Upper Canada Academy by Royal Charter, in the year 1835. In 1841 the institution obtained University powers, and changed its name to "Victoria College." In 1850 power was given to remove to Toronto. It has now Faculties in Arts, Theology, Law, Medicine and Physical Science. Previous to 1868 an
