

Wew York, Dec. 11—When customs officials at Hoboken searched the baggage of W. B. Ellis, a Boston business man, on his arrival here they found a reindeer coat which had been given Mr. Ellis by "the Queen of the Laplanders," a gold sword once the property of Gen. Michailoff, war minister under Kerensky, a golden crucifix from the ancient monastery at Nolomogir, which had been a present from the Emperor Paul in 1797, the gold war cross of St. Stantislaus and more than 2,000,000 roubles in Russian money, including a complete series of Soviet currency.

Most of the souvenirs belong to Mr. Ellis, but the money belongs to 'the Y. M. C. A. Mr. Ellis was controller for the American "Y" in North Russia and when the Red Triangle was ordered to evacuate last September, he closed accounts and withdrew with the unexpended funds.

At Archangel, he said, three yachts were kept under steam in the harbor ready for the immediate departure of Russian officials should the Bolshevists capture the city.


