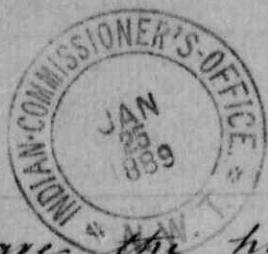

Sir,

I have the honour to inform you, that I have received instructions from General Manager, Sir John L. Kaye, to lay down a division fence, on the boundary line, between the Blackfoot Indian Reserve on the East side, and The Can. Agr. C. and Col. Co's Lands on the West side; extending from the Canadian Pacific Railway on the North, and the Bow River on the South.

Having no information concerning 'roadway allowances', which I believe extends along Reserve boundaries; I would be glad to learn from you, whether said roadway be located within Reserve boundaries, or has to be allowed for outside of it.
