DR. GATES' FAREWELL.

Immense Audience in Germain Street Baptist Church Last Evening. Listen to Their Beloved Pastor's Eloquent Farewell Address After Fifteen Years of Faithful Service.

At Germain street Baptist church Sunday evening every seat was filled and chairs had to be placed along all the aisles to accommodate the great numbers that assembled to hear Dr. Gates' last sermon in that church after a pastorate of fifteen years.

Dr. Gates took for the text of his discourse I. Corinthians, I. and 18: "For ye are foolish because ye were perishing to those, however, who were saved the gospel was still the power of God."

He graphically sketched the circumstances under which the epistle was written and showed how Paul's wonderful gospel story seemed as foolishness to the bigoted Jew and to the cultured Greek.

In closing Dr. Gates said he had no formal address of farewell to give. He would speak his last words to the members of his church Monday evening.
