those of the fruit growers, so that it becomes necessary to fix the dates when the most important interests will be best secured. This year, the late-ness of the season seems still more unfortunate, as fruit is at least two or three weeks later than usual. Notwithstanding the disadvantages referred to, the fruit growers of New Brunswick have made a creditable showing of fruit. Nova Scotia was also represented in the exhibit, but growers from there assured your judge that their fruit was too green to put in exhibition. In general, the fruit was as good as the unfavorable conditions would lead one to expect. The exhibits of Geo. McAlpine convinced me that New Brunswick can grow as fine fruit as Nova Scotia. In this case, the New Brunswick fruit was the better. Several of the country exhibits are deserving of special mention. That shown by Mr. McAlpine was especially good, containing a large variety of well grown fruit, including the small fruits. The exhibits easily won the highest prize, both in country and general exhibits. Mr. Gorham also had a well arranged, creditable exhibit, and the others were less extensive, they were good; though your judge in one case felt it his duty to award second prize where there was no competition. From what I learned, the exhibitors hardly realized the full meaning of the products called for, as there were only a few plates of apples and one plate of pears. The idea of offering prizes for local (N. B.) products is an excellent one, and your judge hopes you may feel like continuing the exhibition in the future, until all the counties shall be well represented. Elsewhere I have offered a few suggestions for the consideration of your executive committee. I hope you may find them helpful in your future work. It gives me pleasure to commend the work of S. L. Peters in the charge of the fruit exhibit, and his assistance in agricultural hall. The exhibits are well arranged, well cared for, and very attractive to visitors. You are fortunate in securing such efficiency. I wish to thank you for the cordial reception I have received while stopping in your beautiful city, and to congratulate you on the grand success of your exhibition, which is indeed a grand "gala day" for all the people of St. John, and many visitors from far and near. All of which is most respectfully submitted.

SHORT TALKS.

The whole exhibit, beautifully arranged, is a splendid object lesson of the size and production of that country. Members of the C. P.
