At the re-opening of the school in September, after very fully considering the matter, the teachers deemed it unwise to continue the fortnightly meetings for the winter, but have decided to bring the matter more definitely before the scholars in the school, and with this in view have placed the temperance pledge within reach of every scholar. Already quite a number have availed themselves of the opportunity of signing.
