OUR COVER: The Depot Division parade square rings with the barked commands of drill instructor, Sgt. D. Will. Three troops of recruits, lined up in order of seniority, stand 'at ease', attentive for the next order. The senior troop is the first two files of female constables. The male constables following them are junior troops which began their recruit training at a later date. The last troop, pictured on our back cover, is dressed in 'fatigue' pants as their blue service-order trousers were still being tailored. This troop had just arrived at Depot. The building in the background houses the officers' mess and living quarters. The brass canon in the foreground is a seven-pounder, one of two that stand on either side of the Honour Roll memorial at Depot. Both guns were acquired by the Force in 1876, and were used by "B" Battery School of Gunnery militiamen in the battle of Cutknife Hill in 1885.

With this cover, the forwarding address by the commanding officer of Depot (page 6), the article on the history of Depot (page 7), and another on Depot's training program (page 17), *the Quarterly* pays tribute to Depot Division on the occasion of its 100th anniversary.
