ART. III.

Truftees are to within fourteen months, of the money they shall have collected, and afterwards as hands sufficient to pound.

If there should be any furplus, it is to be paid to the order of the ab-Sentec.

The truftees and the furvivors or furvivor of them, shall make a dividend, within fourteen months after the time of their election or nomination, make an equal and rateable dividend of such monies as they shall have collected and received, amongst often as they shall all the creditors who shall have proved their debts withhave money in in the time above limited; and shall afterwards make dipay 6d. in the vidends as often as they shall have money in hand, sufficient to pay the creditors fix-pence in the pound.

If any furplus should remain in the hands of the trustees or the furvivors or furvivor of them, after paying allthe debts due by fuch absentee, proved as aforesaid; the fame shall be paid to such person as shall be empowered:

The truftees empowered to fue, Sic.

The truftees, elected and approved of, or nominated as aforesaid; and the survivors or survivor of them, arehereby empowered to profecute, maintain, and defend: any action or actions for the benefit and advantage of the estate of the absentee, in any of the courts of justice in. this province, as fully and effectually as the absence himfelf might do, if he was present.

Persons who shall have conformed Scribed for obtaining a pals, if they ablent them lelves for more than a twelve-month, their creditors against their e-Rates and effects,

Wherever any person who shall have complied with the. to the rules pre- rules prescribed in the before recited ordinance, shall have: been absent from the province for upwards of a twelve-. from the province month, the creditors of such person are hereby empower. ed, after that period, to proceed to the nomination and: election of trustees to his estate and esfects,, and to the sale: may proceed, after that period, thereof, and the distribution of the proceeds thereof, in the same manner as is herein before directed to be done, in manner afore- concerning fuch persons as shall leave the province without conforming to the faid rules.
