are permitted by the first Article of the Convention of 1818 to fish in the bays, creeks, or harbours of Her Britannic Majesty's dominions, provided that they do not approach within three marine miles of the *shore* of any such bay, creek, or harbour, and that on the contrary the Government of Great Britain is justified in maintaining that the United States fishermenare by that Article prohibited from fishing within three marine miles of the *entrance* of any of the bays, creeks, or harbours of Her Britannic Majesty's dominions in America, with the exception of those bays, creeks, or harbours previously specified in the earlier part of the same article.
