[Note:—The Returns to the Custom House from the British North American Colonies, having been destroyed by Fire, no perfect Account can be rendered of the Total Quantity of Fish exported therefrom during the years previous to 1814.—The following Account is therefore submitted, (N° 2.) as the best Statement that can now be given, of Fish of all Sorts exported from those Colonies to all Parts, except the British West India Islands, from the year 1814 inclusive, to the latest period to which the Returns are received.]
