And be it further enacted, That an Act made in the Forty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for continuing until the First Day of July One thousand eight hundred and four, an Act passed in the Forty-second Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, 'An Act for regulating, until the Fifteenth Day of February One thousand eight hundred and three, the Prices at which Grain, Meal, and Flour may be exported from Great Britain to Ireland, and from Ireland to Great Britain;* and also an Act made in the Forty-fourth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, for continuing the said Act, and for permitting the Exportation of Seed Corn from Great Britain to Ireland, and the Importation of Malt into Great Britain from Ireland; and which was further continued by Two Acts of the Forty-fourth and Forty-fifth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and six, shall be, and the same is hereby revived and further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and eight.

VII. And be it further enacted, That so much of an Act, made in the Forty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to repeal the Duties of Customs payable in Great Britain, and to grant other Duties in lieu thereof,* as relates to the Admission to Entry of Oil or Blubber of Fish, or Creatures living in the Sea, actually caught and taken on the Banks and Shores of the Island of Newfoundland and Parts adjacent wholly by His Majesty's Subjects carrying on the said Fishery from the said Island, and residing therein, on Payment of the Duty by the said Act imposed on Train Oil or Blubber of Newfoundland of British Fishing, which was to continue in force until the Twenty-fifth Day of December One thousand eight hundred and four; and which was, by Two Acts passed in the Forty-fourth and Forty-fifth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and six, shall be, and the same is hereby revived and further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and eight.
