I have carefully examined
the above lots and find that lot 14 is mostly
all covered with water except a very small
part in the center of the lot which is timbered
with very small sedge and only a little of which
is fit for pickets and no pine lot all rock and
not fit for farming purposes and I believe it
is worth at most eighteen 18 or twenty 20 dollars in
cash at most for land and timber free of dues
and in the matter of lot 17

can 7 EBR. It is all green small sedge
fit for pickets but mostly to small for
that there may be about two or three hundred
lies on on the north east corner of the lot no pine
timber lot all rock and not fit for farming
purposes and I believe the lot is worth at most
thirty five 35 dollars in cash for land and timber
free of dues and that is the full value of the
lot and timber
