Uplands, Ontario	16 May 1943		Rain all day. No flying. As a special show, the preview of May 18th's movie was presented in the W.D. Recreation Centre in the evening. The usual Church Services were held in the morning and were well attended.	
	17 May 1943		Partly cloudy. Pilot Officer W.W.A. Secord (J26023), when taxiing Harvard 3017 at St. Hubert, applied brakes as crash truck drove past in front of him. Brakes seized and propeller struck the ground. C-1 category. No injury. Site of accident - Main Aerodrome, St. Hubert, Que. Semi-finals of airmen's Softball - Headquarters eliminated Training Wing 3 to 1.	
	18 May 1943		Light haze. Clear to cloudy. GB1396134 LAC Stevens, E.D. ground looped Harvard 2933 on landing. Very slight damage to wing tip. D-1 category. No injury. Main Aerodrome. Flying Officer J.H.R. Lester (J13341), while making a turn in Harvard 3791 over the bombing range, allowed the aircraft to lose height sufficiently to strike the surface of the lake while coming out of turn. Damage to prop, engine cowling and port wing. C-1 category. No injury. Site of incident - Bombing Range, Lake Deschenes.	
	19 May 1943		Overcast. Flying Officer D.W. Partridge (J14334) with R182450 LAC Patten, J.G. as student, failed to take over in time to prevent Harvard 3012 from ground looping. D-1 category. No injury. Main Aerodrome. Sports:- Semi-Finals of Volleyball and Bordenball - Repair Squadron defeated Training Wing in former, and Headquarters Squadron defeated Repair Squadron in latter.	
	20 May 1943		Cloudy. Softball Final Series - Servicing Squadron defeated Headquarters. Very warm, beautiful day. Flying continuous throughout. Flt/B Sparrow, W.D. Staff Officer, #3 T.C.H.Q., visited sections of Station where W.D. personnel employed. Captain Frank Guy Armitage entertained Station personnel in the Recreation Hall in the evening, with his series of impersonations of Dickens' characters. Local musical artists provided preludes between acts.	
	21 May 1943		Overcast. Poured rain all day.	
	22 May 1943		Clear to partly cloudy. Flying continuous all day.
