Ottawa, May 17, 1910

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 15th instant, making application on behalf of the Regina Country Club to either purchase or lease Indian Reserve No. 80, situate on Long Lake, Saskatchewan, and in reply to say that no disposition of an Indian Reserve can be made by the Department until after surrender by the Indians under and in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Act. In this particular instance I may say that recently the Indians declined to consider the proposition submitted to them for surrender of their reserve, and the Department is, therefore, unable to entertain a proposition either for sale or lease.
