Sir:-

Referring to your letter of the 3th instant, relative to the distribution of interest money for the Spring of 1913 to Indians of the Walpole Island Band, I transmit under separate cover for your guidance a copy of the Pottawattemies pay-list for September 1901. I also send you three blank pay-lists for use when making the distribution for the Spring of 1913. The pay-list for 1901 should be returned to the Department. A duplicate of it should be on file in your office. You should be careful in making out the pay-list to see that no errors occur. Payment should be made and the money accounted for at an early date.

When sending in the pay-list you should forward a statement of the amount of money you received, the amount paid out and the amount, if any, remaining in your hands after the distribution, which latter amount should be refunded to Headquarters.
