


Ottawa, 15th December, 1914.

Referring to your letter of the 16th instant, relative to the contracts for Treaty 8 and Lesser Slave Lake Agency for 1915, I beg to state that the Department will advance payment on the basis of one half of the total amount of the contract, after the supplies have been inspected at the mill. This advance payment is voluntary and is subject to the proviso that it shall not be construed as in any way affecting the conditions and obligations of the contract.
