The Minister verses to be repeated by the Congregation.

THE Lord hear thee in the day of trouble : the Name of the God of Jacob defend thee :

1 Send thee help from the sanctuary : and strengthen thee out of Zion :

2 Remember all thy offerings : and accept thy burnt-sacrifice :

3 Grant thee thy heart's desire : and fulfil all thy mind.

4 We will rejoice in thy salvation, and triumph in the Name of the Lord our God : the Lord perform all thy petitions.

5 Now know I, that the Lord helpeth his Anointed, and will hear him from his holy heaven : even with the wholesome strength of his right hand.
