Provided always, that all and every order or orders issued and published under the authority of the aforesaid A^d, or which shall be issued or published under the authority of this A^d, shall not continue and be in force longer than to the said first day of January one thousand eight hundred and eight, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament.
