Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations.

THE sole head of a lamily, or any male over 18 y, are old, may homestead a quarter section of ayailable Dominion land in Manutoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (out not Sub-Agency,) on certain conditions.

certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm o at least 30 acres, on certain conditions A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning housestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.

Asettler who has exhausted no none-isead right may take a purhased home-tead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 pe care. Duties—Must reside six mogh-nated three years, cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$500.

The arr of cultivation is subject to eduction in case of rough, scrubby or ony land. Live stock may be substi-uted for cultivation under certain con-litings.

ALLIES SEND MORE TROOPS, TO SALQNIKI

London, Oct. 20-Additional Entente forces have been sent to Saloniki according to Reuter's correspondence there, who sends word that a further strong contingent of infantry was landed today, and that several detachments of Greek troops have arrived from Crete to join the Nationalist army. The Provisional Government at Saloniki has received a lengthy telegram embodying resolutions passed at a meeting of Greeks in New York and promising men and funds to the Nationalist cause. The Provisional Government, says the despatch, is sending a committee to New York for the urpose of organizing and transporting troops.
