**Fishing Village Swept Away**  
NAPLES, Feb. 10.—A severe  
storm has caused serious damage on  
the Calabrian Coast. At Marina, D.  
I. Canticaro, a fishing village, a  
tidal wave swept in and practically  
destroyed the village. The loss of  
life was large and several houses col-  
lapsed and everything portable was  
carried away by the water. The peo-  
ple of the village have sought refuge  
in the surrounding hills. At Mes-  
sina the storm was very severe and  
caused considerable damage. A land-  
slide at Guidamandari buried a house  
and three persons lost their lives.

**Hotel Burns at Syracuse.**  
SYRACUSE, N. Y., Feb. 10.—Early  
this morning one of the most destruc-  
tive fires in the history of the town  
broke out in the heart of the busi-  
ness section. The fire started in the  
Mowry Hotel, which was completely  
destroyed. The inmates of the build-  
ings escaped, but they lost all their  
belongings. Several other small  
buildings were also burned before the  
blaze was extinguished. The total  
loss is placed at \$200,000. Several  
persons were injured, but none  
seriously.
