The evidence showed that, upon being taken prisoner by the Germans in France, Perimutter spoke to his captor in German and conversed with

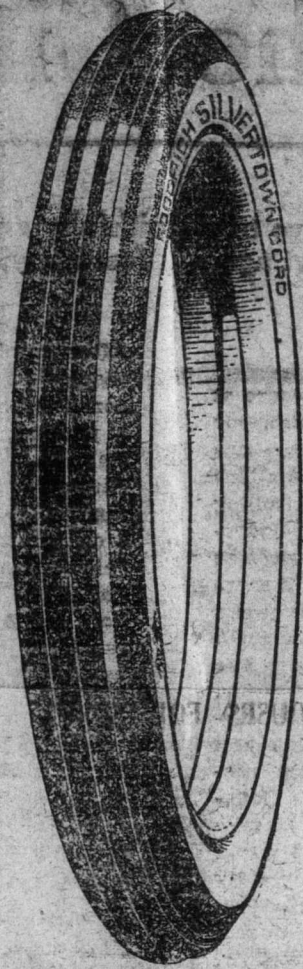

SMALLPOX ON WANE

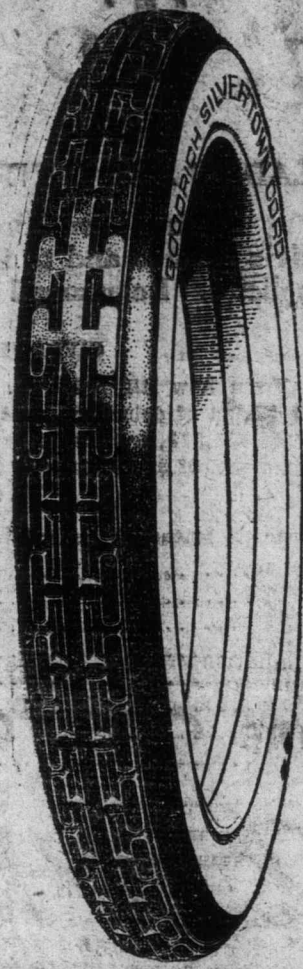
